### Summary

The Sybil Irving Memorial in New South Wales is a seat with plaque between established Plane trees (*Platanus cuneata*) in Wynyard Street (near The Royal Australian Regiment Memorial), Sydney, unveiled by Lady Cutler, wife of the Governor of New South Wales, dedicated by The Very Reverend Lance Shilton 3 October 1978. The seat is now located in the Jessie Street Gardens.
