She gained Fellowship of the Faculty of Anaesthetists at the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons in 1986, which made her a Foundation Fellow of the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists (ANZCA) in 1992.

Genevieve has taken a leading role in the formation and continuation of the Welfare of Anaesthetists Special Interest Group which began in 1997. Elected as ANZCA President in 2014, she was the fourth successive woman President. Her presidency centred on professionalism, workforce, advocacy, and strengthening ANZCA and Faculty of Pain Management services.

She was appointed a Member of the Order of Australia (AM) in 2023 for significant service to anaesthesiology through professional and clinical roles.
